Additional edits/validations shall be applied to the DDTC license data as follows:

- The reported **DDTC Registration Number** must match an *active* Registrant on file in AES. An electronic SED shall not be accepted if the Registrant is found to be no longer active (i.e., 'expired').
- A Foreign Military Sales license claim (i.e., the reporting of **License Code** 'S94') requires the reporting of an **Export Information Code** of 'FS', 'FI', 'GS', or 'MS'. If the 'FS', 'FI', 'GS', or 'MS' code does not accompany an 'S94' claim, the shipment transaction will be rejected.
- An **Export Information Code** of 'FS' or 'FI' will not be accepted for other than a **License Code** claim of 'S94'. If the 'FS' or 'FI' code accompanies other that an 'S94' claim, the shipment transaction will be rejected.
- The acceptable format of an **Export License Number** when the filer makes a Foreign Military Sales license claim (i.e., the reporting of **License Code** 'S94') is:

"AA-A-AAA"

Where 'A' represents an alphanumeric character and '-' represents a dash. Left-justify and space fill. If an 'S94' license number is formatted in any other manner, the shipment transaction will be rejected.

- The reported **DDTC Unit of Measure Code** must be a value in the DDTC Unit of Measure Code list (AESTIR Appendix W).
- When reported, a **DDTC ITAR Exemption Number** must be a value in the DDTC ITAR Exemption Code list (AESTIR Appendix O).
- The reported **DDTC USML Category Code** must be a value in the DDTC USML Category Code list (AESTIR Appendix L).

• The reporting of a 'Canadian' ITAR Exemption (i.e., **License Code** 'SCA') requires that the **Country of Ultimate Destination** be reported as Canada (i.e., CA).

Additional filing notes:

- Filings that do not conform to the above edits and validations will be fatally rejected.
- In a proprietary format filing do not report the new ODT record unless required.
- When reported in a proprietary filing, the ODT record must be transmitted immediately following the CL2 record.
- The edits and validations for non-DDTC shipments will not change. Continue to report as instructed in AESTIR Appendix F.
