What is in a petition for a WRO and/or finding modification or revocation?

Include

- Credible audit results
- Corrective action plan
- Corrective action plan implementation $\mathbf{\vee}$
- Evidence of forced labor indicator \checkmark remediation and verification by the same third-party auditors







What is a Credible Audit?

A credible audit includes the following elements:

- Unannounced independent, third-party audit
- All indicators of forced labor addressed
- Interviews completed in native language

What is a Corrective Action Plan?

A corrective action plan includes the following elements:

- All audit findings
- Actions required to remedy identified forced labor indicators
- Verification and implementation of forced labor indicator remediation
- Clear timeline of milestones to complete Consequences if no action taken
